*Open to In Hand Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age.*

*This class may be divided as appropriate. **Class 5&6***

**EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND** *Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider any age. This class may be divided as appropriate. **Class 29&30***

**CAVERNOMA ALLIANCE UK / EQUIFEST MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LEAD REIN** *Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a Snaffle Bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only. **Class 17***

**THE JUNGLE HUT / EQUIFEST MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND FIRST RIDDEN** *Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle. **Class 19***

### NEDZ / EQUIFEST MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND WORKING HUNTER PONIES

*Mountain and Moorland Working Hunter pony, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland or Welsh A, B, C or D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Riders any age. If classes are divided, they must be divided by height and NOT by Breed, i.e.\* Not exceeding 122cms. \* Exceeding 122cms but not exceeding 133cms.\* Exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms.\* Exceeding 143cms. HEIGHT OF FENCES FOR M&M WHP CLASSES: CLASS MINIMUM HEIGHT MAXIMUM HEIGHT MAXIMUM SPREAD Not exceeding 122cm 55cms 65cms 55cms, 122cms – 133cms 65cms 75cms 65cms 133cms – 143cms 75cms 85cms 75cms Exceeding 143cms 85cms 95cms 75cms The course should consist of not less than 7 fences and should contain a change of direction and a spread fence. The course must be built between the minimum and maximum heights, according to the condition of the ring and the standard of entry. **EQUIFEST RIDDEN SHOW PONIES** *Open Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 148cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Classes may be divided as follows:\* Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 13th birthday before 1st January in the current year.\* Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 128cms but not exceeding 138cms. Riders not to have attained their 15th birthday before 1st January in the current year.\* Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 138cms but not exceeding 148cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year. **Class 24***

**THE MILNER FAMILY / EQUIFEST SHOW PONY LEAD REIN** *Leading Rein Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only. **Class 18***

**THE COLES SHOW TEAM / EQUIFEST SHOW PONY FIRST RIDDEN** *First Ridden Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cm. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle. **Class 20***

**KBIS / EQUIFEST RIDDEN SHOW HUNTER PONIES** Show Hunter Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Classes may be divided as follows: \* Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. \* Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 122cms but not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. \* Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year. \* Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year. **Class 25**

**SS LANDSCAPES / EQUIFEST SHOW HUNTER PONY- LEAD REIN** Show Hunter Pony – Lead Rein, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Rider not to have attained their 9th Birthday before 1st January in the current year. **Class 18**

**KBIS / EQUIFEST WORKING HUNTER PONIES** Working Hunter Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders must be the correct age for the animal they ride. If this classification is run as one class, fences must be adjusted for each height section. Classes may be divided as follows: \* Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. \* Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year. \* Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year. \* Open Intermediate Working Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years or over, exceeding 148cms and not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year. **HEIGHT OF FENCES FOR WHP / INT WH CLASSES: CLASS MINIMUM HEIGHT MAXIMUM HEIGHT MAXIMUM SPREAD** Not exceeding 133cm 70cms 85cms, 133cms – 143cms 75cms 90cms 90cms, 143cms – 153cms 85cms 100cms 100cms, 148cms – 158cms 95cms 105cms. The course should consist of not less than 7 fences and should contain a change of direction and a spread fence. The course must be built between the minimum and maximum heights, according to the condition of the ring and the standard of entry. **NUPAFEED / EQUIFEST RIDDEN COBS** Open Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. Riders any age. Classes may be divided as follows: \* Open Lightweight Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. \* Open Heavyweight Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. **Class 22**

**BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES / EQUIFEST RIDDEN HUNTERS** Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 153cms. Riders any age. Classes may be divided as follows: \* Lightweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, capable of carrying up to 12.7 stone. \* Middleweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, capable of carrying 12.7 stone but not 14 stone. \* Heavyweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over capable of carrying over 14 stone. **Class 25**

**R CRABTREE AGRI SERVICES / EQUIFEST OPEN SMALL HUNTERS** Open Small Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age. **Class 25**

**BSPA / EQUIFEST RIDDEN PIEBALD / SKEWBALD** Open ridden Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Riders any age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championship. Subject to their show rules & conditions. Classes may be divided according to entries. **Class 26 & 27**

**BSPA / EQUIFEST IN HAND PIEBALD / SKEWBALD** Open in Hand Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championships. Subject to their show rules & conditions Classes may be divided according to entries. **Class 8**

**JUNIOR RIDDEN MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND** Mares and geldings, 4 years old & over, registered in the respective pure bred Stud Books of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh Section A,B,C & D. Riders of Small Breeds not to have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders of Large Breeds not to have attained their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1st January in the current year. **Class 29 & 30**

## **Stars Champion of Champions**

Highest placed point's winner will qualify for the relevant class. If this member is unable to attend we will pass this qualification down.

Stars champion of champions is held at Aintree Racecourse 18<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup> October 2019.

Please can all members make sure they have read the rules for this show and ALL ponies MUST be vaccinated?

Class 3 will be split into age category at the end of the season

## **The Showing Register**

TSR Showing Finals - This show is a qualifier for the 2019 TSR Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR Riders Finals - 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR In Hand Finals - The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward; cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at <http://www.theshowingregister.co.uk/>

BSHA Grass Roots Championships - With a TSR qualification flyer you can also enter the BSHA Grass Roots Champs on the 9th Sept at Addington Equestrian Centre - You do not have to be a BSHA member to qualify or enter the final. See <http://www.britishshowhorse.org>

## **Trailblazers**

### **Qualification for the Trailblazers Championship Finals**

#### **Numbers to Qualify**

The 4 highest placed combinations will qualify from each Showing & Working Hunter Qualifier for the Trailblazers Championship Finals regardless of the number of entries in the Qualifier.

#### **Qualifying Partnerships**

Only qualified partnerships (horse / pony and rider) from a Trailblazers Qualifier are eligible to compete at the Trailblazers Championship Finals.

Once qualifying partnerships have purchased their qualification card and sent it to the Trailblazers Show Secretary they are permitted to enter any Showing or Working Hunter Class for which they are eligible to compete in.

#### **Qualification Letter**

Once a Competitor has qualified at a Trailblazers Qualifier they will be issued with an envelope from the Venue at which they have qualified containing a congratulatory letter telling them that they have qualified. The Competitor will then have the choice to take up the qualification or not. Should the Competitor decide to accept the qualification for the Championship Finals, they will return the congratulatory letter (within 14 days) together with the appropriate fee and a stamped addressed envelope (SAE), to the Venue of Qualification. The SAE will be used to return a Qualification Card. Once the qualification card has been received the competitor must send this onto the Trailblazers Show Secretary (details on the qualification card) in order to be sent a Trailblazers Championship Finals schedule at the beginning of June prior to the Championships.

# CLUB RULES 2019

1. In any dispute the committee's decision is final.
2. Correct riding dress must be worn by all riders. Hard hat must be worn by all ridden competitors and must be the correct safety standard, on entering the ring.
3. Whips should not exceed 30"
4. The excessive use of whips on the show ground is forbidden.
5. Entry fees will not be refunded.
6. The name of the horse or pony should be kept for the entire season as points are awarded for combination of animal/rider. This will avoid two sets of points being started.
7. Stallions may enter from 3 years old. (Senior members only).
8. NO late entry. Once the class has started we will not allow anyone enter the ring late
9. It is up to the competitor to ensure that they are entered in the correct class.
10. To be eligible for points, the rider/horse/pony must have competed in the class at a minimum of 4 points shows.
11. A child who has not attained his/her 3rd birthday at the 1st January 2019 may not compete in any of the classes.
12. All horses/ponies ages are at the 1st January 2019. No horse/pony 3 years or under may be ridden on the field.
13. The Club can not be held responsible to any member of the public for injury, damage, theft etc.
14. Falling off rule will apply. Anyone falling from Horse/Pony will be eliminated from the class for Health & Safety reasons and must leave the ring.
15. The judge's decision is final.
16. Complaints must be lodged in writing to either the Secretary or Chairman with a deposit of £25.
17. Regulation Hard Hats and Safety Harness must be worn by all riders when mounted at all times.
18. Working Hunter Marking -: Jumping = 50pts, Conformation & freedom of action = 50pts Total = 100pts. Penalties: Knock down = 10pts, First Refusal = 15pts, Second Refusal = 20pts, Third Refusal = Disqualification, fall of horse or rider = Elimination.
